

Dear Parents:

The 2018 28th annual **North Carolina German Immersion Weekend** for advanced German students will be held on **November 2-3, 2018, at Camp Caraway outside of Asheboro.** The camp is sponsored by the N.C. Chapter of the American Association of Teachers of German (AATG). It is a fun tradition that goes back to 1980! Participating students agree to speak German during the entire event, work cooperatively with all students and teachers, and participate in all activities.

The theme for this year's camp is:

"Sport vereint die Welt"
Sport unites the world.



Among the events are:

- *Pyramid Game* (vocabulary description)
- *Group Projects*
- *Photo Scavenger Hunt*
- *Relay Races*
- *Quiz Bowl*

The cost of the camp is \$75/student, which includes transportation, room, 3 meals and a t-shirt. Campers will sleep in bunk beds in their respective rooms (girls' or boys'). Students should also bring comfortable shoes and clothing, rain gear, a flashlight and a digital camera (one per school). Students leave right from school on Friday. The camp lasts approximately 24 hours, from about 5 pm on Friday until about the same time Saturday.
