## "Puzzling for Professional Development"

Presenter: Cori Crane, Duke University

- Introduction: Shifting the goal in language classrooms from problem solving toward understanding
- Some of the problems/puzzles discussed:
  - · How to motivate weak students when all avenues of helping them appear to have failed
  - · Why students speak so quietly in a language class
  - · How to give feedback effectively
  - How to incorporate oral assessment into an existing FL curriculum
  - What familiar classroom practice could I adapt to become a potentially exploitable pedagogic activity (PEPA)?
  - Why integrate learners in teacher reflection?

## "Conversation Circles 2"

Presenter: Larry Land, Waddell Language Academy

- Introduction:
  - How to bring elements of an immersion setting at the primary levels into any classroom
  - How can we support all students in developing and refining their speaking skills in the target language?
- · What we know (our vision):
  - We don't want students to say they can't speak German after having taken German for one or more years.
  - Speaking is the most challenging language skill in which to develop proficiency.
  - Immersion can take language learning to a place beyond memorization.
  - Learning to speak a language is gratifying and cool!
