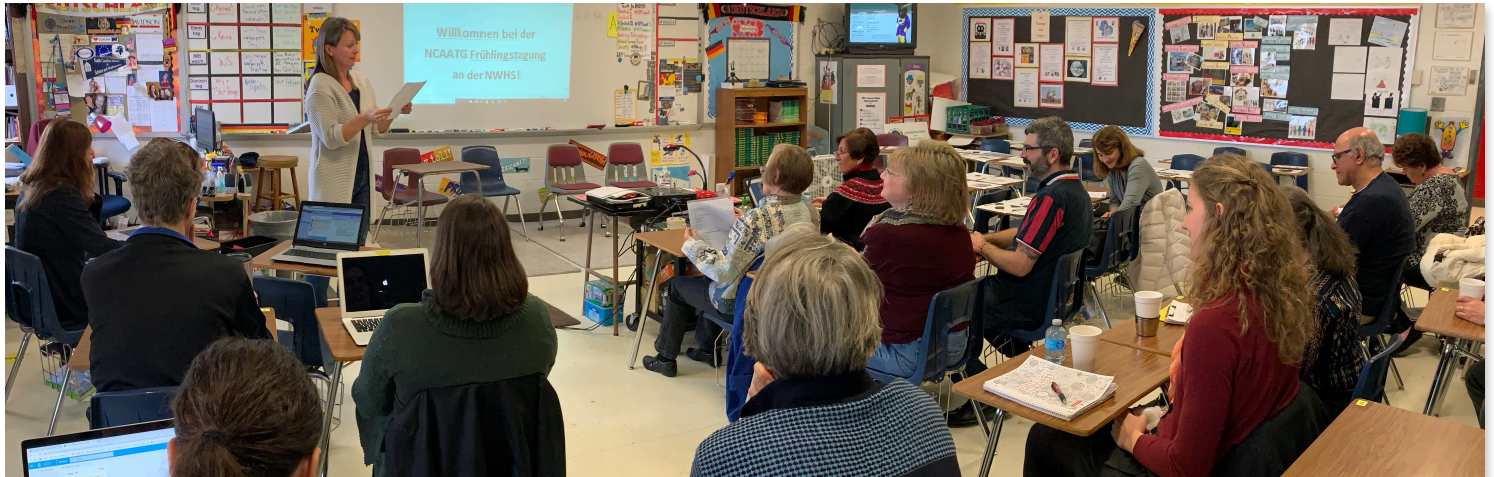

"Student Panel"

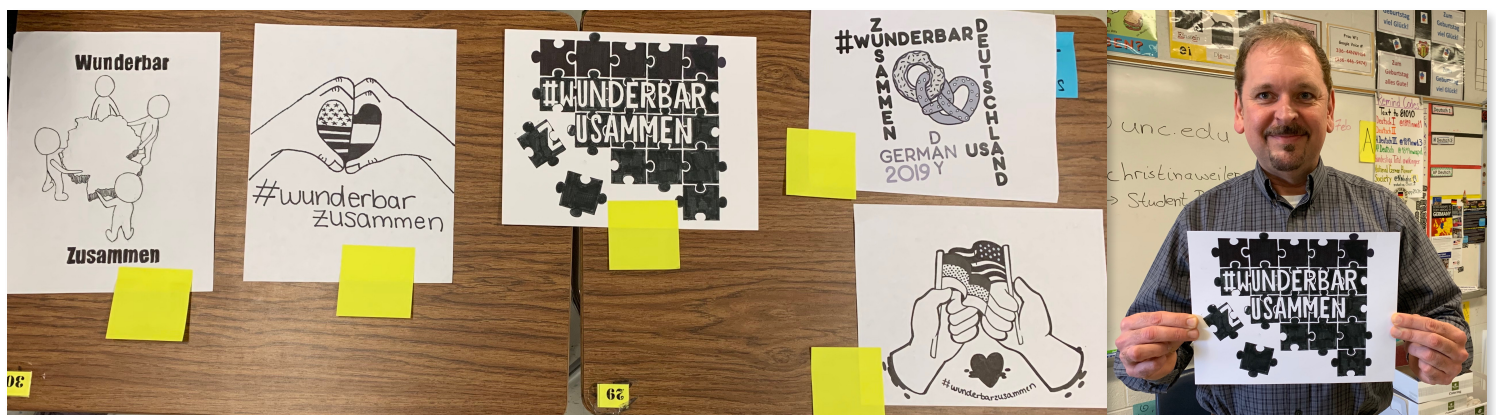
Presenter: Various students from Guilford County secondary and post-secondary schools
